



2019/20 Postgraduate Programmes Bridging Courses

A. Introduction

Per the admission requirement, admitted students whose bachelor's degrees are in areas other than hotel and tourism management, food and beverage management, recreation and leisure management, etc. are required to enroll in bridging courses.

Upon reviewing your bachelor's qualification, you are required to enroll in **one** bridging course **with a normal course duration of 40 hours**. A few alternatives are provided in Part B for your consideration.

You are advised to take the bridging course at your earliest convenience to fulfil the admission requirement.

B. Possible offers

B1. Macao Institute for Tourism Studies

IFTM has daytime and evening undergraduate programmes. Courses like "Introduction to Tourism Services" (day course) or "Introduction to Tourism and Hospitality" (evening course) can be considered as bridging courses. If you are interested, please contact Pedagogic Affairs Department for the class schedule.
