



Postgraduate Programmes Bridging Courses

A. Introduction

Per the admission requirement of the Postgraduate Programmes, shortlisted applicants who possess a bachelor's degree in areas other than **hotel and tourism management, food and beverage management, recreation and leisure management** are required to enroll in at least one bridging course with a normal course duration of 40 hours to fulfill the admission requirement. The students are responsible for paying the fees upon enrolling the bridging courses.

Students are required to complete the bridging course within 6 months once they are registered in the programmes. A few alternatives are provided in Part B.
